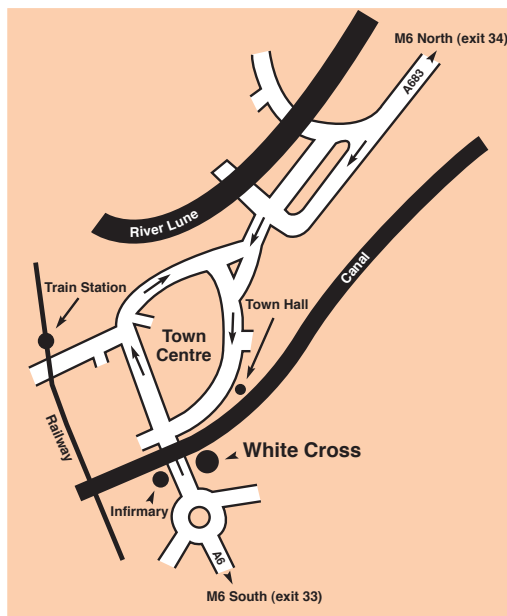

All Origin personal assistants attend an intensive three day spinal injury training programme with work shadowing, to equip them with the essential skills for the role of personal assistant. There are also options for further training which may lead to health and social care qualifications.

The Role of a Personal Assistant

Whilst sometimes challenging, it is a genuine opportunity to make a real difference to the quality of someone else's life.
